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ABSTRACT

This report presents the final results of the initial three-year **New York Energy \$martSM** Public Benefits Program (July 1, 1998 and June 30, 2001) and interim information on the status of, and findings from, the ongoing evaluation of this Program. This report is a result of continuous tracking of Program progress in meeting New York's public policy goals of: (1) promoting competitive markets for energy efficiency services, and (2) providing direct benefits to electricity ratepayers or be of clear economic or environmental benefit to the people of New York. The report serves as an integral component to determining the outcomes and ultimate success of the **New York Energy \$martSM** Program. This Evaluation and Status Report will help NYSERDA to assess progress and modify programs as necessary to improve program performance and guide development of future program efforts.

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
