# Energy Efficiency Portfolio Standard

## White Paper

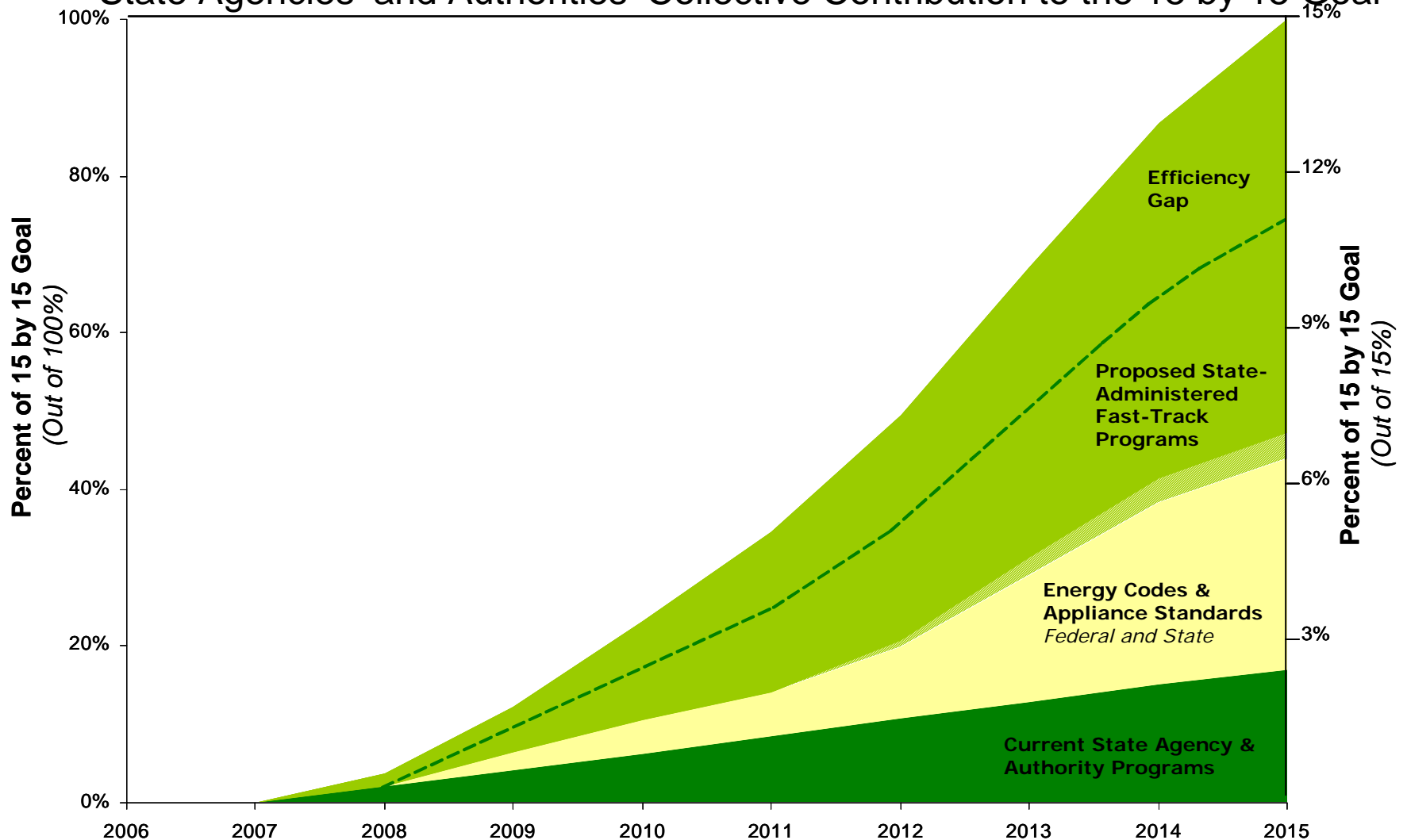
- Initial proposal for collaborative and governance structure with roles for NYSERDA, NYPA, LIPA, DEC, DASNY, DOS, State agencies and authorities, utilities, and key stakeholders
- Included guiding principles for development of sustainable programs
- Identified centralized service platforms — statewide marketing; centralized data gathering, data sharing, and reporting; and evaluation
- Presented first outline of fast track programs

  - Early EE gains, maintaining momentum

  - State agencies and authorities

## EPS Proceeding – Case 07-M-0548

- Longer-term Track to address overarching issues and EPS design
- Four Working Groups – four charges
  - WG I: Overall EPS Structure (respective roles of participants)
  - WG II: EE resource acquisition; MT, end-use customer, electricity and natural gas
  - WG III: Establishing targets and benchmarks, M&V, electricity and natural gas
  - WG IV: Emerging Technologies; next generation for network mgmt., DM/LM, *etc.*

## EPS Proceeding – Case 07-M-0548

- Working Groups began work September 2007; meeting regularly, sharing information
- Expect to report out areas of consensus, areas needing further work 12/5
- Plenary Meeting scheduled for 12/14
- Expect Recommended Decision from ALJ's early 2008 – opportunity for comment
