### County-Level Regional Partners

*Industrial Development Agencies (IDA) are New York State-sanctioned entities authorized to issue taxable and tax-exempt industrial development revenue bonds, tax abatement, loan services, and other assistance for qualified projects. Such projects include commercial, industrial, manufacturing, tourism, and certain undertakings in the not-for-profit sector. The bonds, for example, are usually purchased by banks, investment bankers, insurance companies and other financial institutions selected by the benefited company. The lease or purchase payments equal the debt service payments due on the bonds. This structure enables the benefited company to realize significant exemptions from certain New York State taxes, while also providing the same security to the financial institution purchasing the bonds as in conventional financing. IDAs exist across New York State at the county level, and in some areas at the local level. Those listed below are county IDAs.*
